LaGrange Fire Department Responds to Apartment Fire on North Cary Street

LaGrange, Ga. January 9, 2021 – The LaGrange Fire Department was dispatched on Saturday, January 9th at 4:18 a.m. to 64 North Cary Street for the report of a structure fire.

The first units arrived on the scene and witnessed heavy fire coming from the upstairs apartment. LaGrange Police Department was on the scene and went door to door alerting and evacuating tenants from their apartments.

Command and accountability units were established & Fire personnel began a quick fire attack. Fire crews also performed a primary and secondary search of all eight apartments making sure all the tenants were evacuated from the building.

The fire was under control at 4:52 a.m.

The apartment complex was a total loss. Fire loss estimates are set at \$70,000 to the structure and contents.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

One tenant reported injuries but was not treated by fire personnel.
