LaGrange Fire Department Investigating Arson at 302 Johnson Street

LaGrange, Ga. September 15, 2020 – The LaGrange Fire Department was dispatched September 15th at 10:42 a.m. to a reported structure fire at 302 Johnson Street. The caller reported smoke and flames being visible in the home.



302 Johnson Street

Upon arrival, units found a small fire in the entrance to the crawl space on the rear of the residence. The fire was extinguished with a fire extinguisher with minimal damage to the residence.

This is being investigated as arson due to threats the occupants of the home received related to a domestic dispute.

Felony arrest warrant have been issued for a suspect in this case.

Damage estimates to the home are \$250.
