LaGrange Fire Department Investigating Structure Fire at Assisted Living Facility

LaGrange, Ga. May 24, 2019 – LaGrange Fire Department units were dispatched to a report of a structure fire at 137 Parker Place on Friday, May 24th at 1:19 a.m.

LaGrange Fire Engine 2 was the first fire unit to arrive and reported flames showing through the roof. A defensive attack was initiated, fire called under control at 3:05 am.



Leisure Living is an assisted living facility, which occupies two structures located at 137 Parker Place including Building one and Building two. Building one was the involved structure.

Building one was unoccupied at the time of fire. There were no reported injuries.

The estimated value of Building One is \$341,000. Building One is a total loss.

The cause of the fire is under investigation by the LaGrange Fire Department.
