LaGrange Fire Department Responds to ATV Fire

LaGrange, Ga. May 21, 2020 – The LaGrange Fire Department was dispatched on Wednesday, May 20, at 8:34 p.m. to 407 Country Club Road for the report of a structure fire.

While fire department units were en route Troup County 911 advised that the caller said an ATV in the carport was on fire. The homeowners put the fire out with a hose prior to the arrival of fire units. On arrival firefighters observed light smoke showing from the attic of the carport.

The fire started in the engine area of the ATV.

Damage to the ATV, carport and contents are estimated at \$8,000.

There were no reported injuries.
