## **LaGrange Fire Department Responds to Fire on Sanford Avenue**

*LaGrange, Ga. February 17, 2020* – The LaGrange Fire Department responded to 18 Sanford Avenue in reference to a reported structure fire.



18 Sanford Avenue

First arriving units found light smoke showing from the outside and discovered a mattress that had been burning in an upstairs bedroom. Occupants of the residence extinguished the fire before units arrived on the scene.

The residence received minor smoke damage to the upstairs area. The mattress valued at \$500 has been declared a total loss.

The fire is suspicious in nature, but is still under investigation by the LaGrange Fire Department and the LaGrange Police Department.
