LaGrange Fire Department Responds to Structure Fire on Daniel Court

LaGrange, Ga. December 7, 2020 – The LaGrange Fire Department was dispatched Sunday, December 6th at 3:54 p.m. to 111 Daniel Court for the report of a structure fire.

E5 arrived on the scene and advised smoke showing from the Alpha Delta corner of the resident. Once command and accountability were established, crews noticed fire coming from the electrical meter box

located on the delta side. Fire crews advanced a 1 ¾ attack line to the side of the residence.

City utility crews were called to the scene. Fire crews were able to bring the fire under control and extinguish at 4:45 p.m. Fire damage was contained to the Delta side of the resident.

Fire loss estimates were set at \$5,000.

The cause of the fire was determined to be electrical in nature.

There were no reported injuries
