LaGrange Fire Department Responds to Structure Fire on Jefferson Street

LaGrange, **Ga. August 18**, **2020** – The LaGrange Fire Department was dispatched on Monday, August 17th, at 1:07 p.m. to 506 Jefferson Street for the report of a structure fire.

Firefighters arrived on the scene and observed light smoke coming from the residence. Command and accountability were established, Engine 5 arrived on the scene and advanced a 1 ¾ attack line through the front

door and into the kitchen where they quickly extinguished the fire. The fire was under control and extinguished at 1:25 p.m.

Fire damage was contained to the kitchen. All occupants were outside the residence upon the fire crew's arrival.

Fire loss estimates are \$6,000 to the structure and contents.

The cause of the fire was determined to be a pot left on the stove.

There were no reported injuries
